Report to the Episcopal Church Women Board of Directors

Thank you for the opportunity to serve as your Coordinator for the United Thank Offering and for the support that I have enjoyed throughout my tenure. It has been a great privilege to learn about and to be involved in the larger Episcopal Church.

With the help of Bishop Shannon, the diocesan Office of Mission and Outreach, and the UTO Grants Review Committee, the Diocese of Virginia received funding for three UTO grant requests for this 2016 granting cycle. Grace Aheron received \$2,500 for "Sacred Solidarity: Race Justice at the University of Virginia." This was one of ten Young Adult grants that were awarded. Taylor Poindexter at the Virginia Theological Seminary received \$2,459.99 for expansion of the prayer/meditation gardening project on the seminary grounds. Her request was submitted by Virginia Theological Seminary. In addition, St. Philip's Church in Richmond was granted \$14,315.00 "to level and convert the land of a donated residential home into a garden for food production and education, a safe outdoor play space for children, and a meditation and prayer area near the sixth-oldest historically African American congregation in the Episcopal Church."

Thanks to the support of the ECW Board, the UTO Parish Coordinators, clergy, and participants in the pews throughout the diocese, the UTO Spring In-gathering for 2016 totals \$40,134.08. As you know, "every penny given to the Ingathering is given away the following year to support innovative mission and ministry throughout the Episcopal Church and the Anglican Communion." Let us pray that the Fall Ingatherings will increase this amount and that we will have successful UTO Grant Applications for 2017.

Important dates for the 2017 granting cycle:

- 1st Friday in September 2016 -Young Adult/Seminarian grant application and materials available
- 1st Friday in November 2016-Young Adult/Seminarian application deadline
- 1st Friday in December 2016- Annual UTO grant application and materials available (for local and international/partnership grants)
- 1st Friday in March 2017 Annual UTO grant applications deadline
